1. Introduction

2. Data Controller

3. Collection and Storage of Personal Data and Their Use

a) When Visiting the Website

When you visit our website, the browser used on your device automatically sends information to the server of our website, which is temporarily stored in a log file. The following information is automatically collected and stored until its automatic deletion:

- IP address of the requesting computer,
- Date and time of access,
- Name and URL of the retrieved file,
- Website from which access occurs (referrer URL),
- Browser used, possibly the operating system, and the name of your access provider.

These data are processed for the following purposes:

- Ensuring a smooth connection to the website,
- Ensuring comfortable use of our website,
- Evaluating system security and stability, and
- For administrative purposes.

The legal basis for data processing is Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, as our legitimate interest arises from the purposes of data collection.

b) When Using Our Contact Form

For any inquiries, we offer you the opportunity to contact us through a form on the website. A valid email address is required to identify the source of the inquiry and respond. Additional information can be provided voluntarily. Data processing for the purpose of contacting us is based on your voluntary consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR).

4. Data Sharing

Your personal data will not be shared with third parties unless:

- You have given explicit consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR),
- Sharing is necessary to assert or defend legal claims (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR), or
- There is a legal obligation to share data (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR), or
- It is necessary for contract fulfillment (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR).

5. Cookies

We use cookies on our site. Cookies are small files stored on your device (e.g.,

laptop, tablet, smartphone) when visiting our website. They do not harm your device and do not contain viruses, trojans, or other malware.

The use of cookies helps enhance your experience, optimize the usability, and gather statistical data. Cookies are either session-based, automatically deleted after leaving the site, or temporary and stored for a set period, recognized on subsequent visits. Data processed by cookies are necessary for legitimate interests according to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

6. Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request information about your processed personal data (Article 15 GDPR),
- Request the correction or completion of incorrect data (Article 16 GDPR),
- Request deletion of your data (Article 17 GDPR),
- Restrict the processing of your data (Article 18 GDPR),
- Receive your data in a machine-readable format or request transfer (Article 20 GDPR),
- Withdraw your consent at any time (Article 7(3) GDPR),
- Lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Article 77 GDPR).

7. Data Security

We use SSL (Secure Socket Layer) encryption to ensure secure data transmission.
